During the period, Gyomu Super opened seven stores, resulting in 1,072 stores in total, an increase of 42 stores from a year earlier. Net sales increased driven by the continued coverage on television programs and social media.

Our product shipments to Gyomu Super stores remained strong, with an increase of 3.1% from a year earlier to existing stores in directly managed areas, an increase of 7.4% to all stores in directly managed areas, and an increase of 6.8% to all stores nationwide.

In terms of our product trends, sales of conveniently available frozen vegetables and fruits continued contributing to sales growth, and monthly sales items sold well.
